Dear Prof. Darrell,

Thank you for clarifying that Dr. Hao Li's "Distinguished Fellow" title is an informal title offered by Dr. Kanazawa and not an official title from the university. This information is currently misrepresented by Li as he has listed this title under positions he holds [1] and as an employment position at UC Berkeley [2].

Regardless, offering such a title to any individual from a highly respected academic institution, such as UC Berkeley, would require proper due diligence.

I would assume that, at the time, Dr. Kanazawa was not aware that the Office of Research at the University of Southern California (USC) has been investigating Li's scientific misconduct since 2018. On December 9, 2019, Dr. Kristen Grace—USC's Research Integrity Officer (RIO)—confirmed in writing that Li committed "misrepresentation," "falsification, and research misconduct" during ACM SIGGRAPH Real-Time Live (RTL) 2017. These violations are against the universal scientific code of ethics including USC's code of conduct [3]. Subsequently, Li's employment at USC has been terminated as of June 2020.

I would also assume that Li has falsely represented to Dr. Kanazawa that he has resigned from his position at USC. However, on June 5, 2020, Dr. Kristen Grace confirmed that the termination of Li's employment from USC was not voluntary and that Li "did not resign".

Please let me know if any of my assumptions above are incorrect. And now that Li is associated with UC Berkeley, he is subject to its scientific code of conduct, which also condemns falsification and data fabrication, and therefore subject to investigation by UC Berkeley's VCR and RIO. [4]

Given the above information, please let me know if Dr. Kanazawa, the Computer Vision group, and the EECS department at UC Berkeley would be willing to reconsider the misinformed decision of offering Dr. Li the informal title of a "Distinguished Fellow". Please also let me know if you need any more information or evidence to properly address this research compliance issue and to take appropriate action.

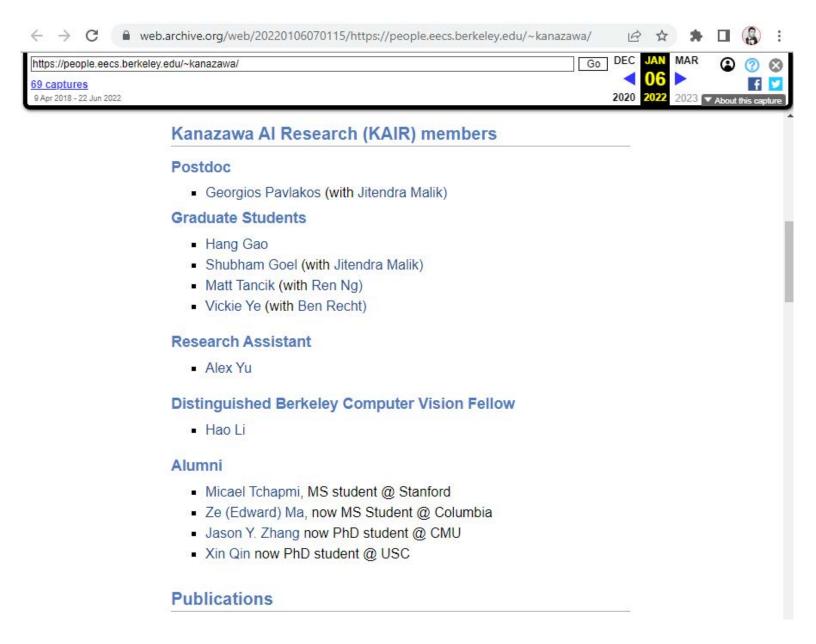

Thank you for your response. I also believe that involving UC Berkeley's VCR and RIO is a move in the right direction to resolve this research compliance issue. To the extent permissible, please keep me posted.

In addition to the question you raised—whether Li is restricted from participating in UC Berkeley's research projects—there is the question of whether offering and failing to revoke the informal title of "Distinguished Fellow" to someone with a history of falsification, data fabrication, and research misconduct is itself against the spirit of the Code.
